I am happy indeed to be able to report to you that The Johns Hopkins Press has come around to our stipulations in regard to both the agreements with Doris and yourself. In the following, I quote from Mr. Geilner's letter to me dated May 1st and am enclosing also a carbon of my response to him. Please note especially the last paragraph pertaining to your involvement.

I hope that we have solved all outstanding problems now in the interest of both Doris and yourself. Johns Hopkins will draft a contract directly with you. I shall be glad to go over it and make sure that it conforms in all details with the one drawn up with the Estate. However, I think the arrangement with the publishers should be an independent one; it is unnecessary that I involve myself as agent in this instance. I am simply very happy that it will be possible to have your wonderful work become part of the projected edition.
